Medicare Open Enrollment Programming and Assistance



Whether you're new to Medicare, getting ready to turn 65, or preparing to retire, you'll need to make several important decisions about your health coverage.

Most people should enroll in Medicare when they turn 65, even if they have health insurance from an employer. There are only certain times when people can enroll. You should sign up for Medicare Hospital Insurance (Part A) **3 months** before your 65th birthday, whether or not you want to begin receiving retirement benefits.
