

Free Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)

First Come/First Served, no appointments

Anyone whose household income is \$60,000 or below may have their state and federal income tax returns completed and e-filed FREE of charge.

What to Bring With You

Having all documentation for identity and income is ESSENTIAL to completing the income tax return efficiently the first time.

- Photo identification
- Social security cards for every member of the household
- Your income information (such as your W-2's and 1099's)
- Last year's tax return
- Your bank routing number and account number (to take advantage of direct deposit for any refunds) **Bring your checkbook!**

Taxpayers must provide documentation of health insurance for every family member.

- Health insurance must meet the Minimum Essential Coverage (MEC) requirements of the Affordable Care Act (ACA).
- Proof of MEC may be found on a Form 1095-C if insurance was obtained through a large employer, or
- On a Form 1095-B if insurance is purchased through a small employer, purchased on the open market, or provided through Medicare or Medicaid, or
- On a Marketplace Form 1095-A, if insurance was purchased through the ACA Marketplace.
