3. **Public Presentation:** The applicant will give a 10-minute public presentation promoting 4-H before a panel of judges. Family, friends, 4-H'ers and candidates are welcome to attend. (30 points possible)

4. **Interview Requirements:** A private interview with the panel of judges will follow the Public Presentation. (30 points possible)
