 Should be typed
 Should not exceed 3 pages, including the first pg

- 10-minute presentation
- Promoting 4-H

Audience will include a panel of 3 judges and family members, fellow 4-H members, etc.
LCD projector, table and easel will be provided

Power Point or visual aids are acceptable Utilize your full 10 minutes Avoid use of note cards or notes Share your personal experiences Practice with your family, friends and mentors before the actual judging Be yourself and have FUN!

* 30 points out of 100 points total
* Interview with a panel of 3 judges
* Questions will be on 4-H, leadership and citizenship experiences
* Maximum of 10 minutes

Maintain eye contact with judges
Talk slowly and clearly
Practice with your family, friends and mentors before the actual judging
