You could not find better role models than Amanda and her siblings. Many Johnson County fairs found them showing dogs, exhibiting clothing construction, showing amazing food exhibits not to forget Amanda dominated the crochet and knitting projects. Amanda took home many purple ribbons and trophies, all while being humble, gracious, and kind.

Amanda needs our help...

From the age of 10 Amanda has been fighting a hard battle with diabetes. 2017 brought dialysis, to Amanda's fight because her kidneys were shutting down. In 2018 a tumor was found on Amanda's heart that had to be removed. August 15, 2018, Amanda received a kidney and pancreas transplant which eventually failed. Amanda has continued being sick which has led to Adult-Onset Still's disease. Followed by Epstein bar Syndrome which was a result from her transplants.

Amanda continued to be sick, in the hospital more than out. On October 29, 2021 after many tests and hospital stays Amanda had both her legs amputated. Amanda has been put through more pain and heartache than most of us have in a lifetime. She is only 29 years old.
