#### Age 7-9

- Develop a savings plan for a specific goal

- ◆ Learn behaviors that develop friendships
- ◆ Understand the need for family rules

#### Age 10-13

- ♦ Understand peer pressure
- ◆Learn to manage a checking account
- ◆Learn socially accepted manners and customs
- ◆ Express feelings in a positive way
- ♦ Learn to cope with change

#### Age 14 +

- ◆ Recognize target advertising
- ◆ Learn the value of employment
- ♦ Understand effects of TV on children
- ◆ Study effects of employment on family and lifestyle
- ♦ Evaluate best uses of credit cards
