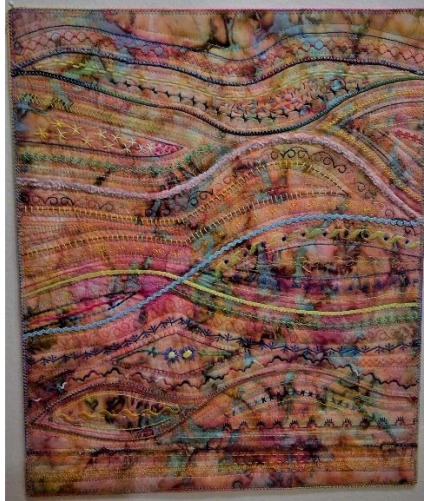


Decorative Machine Stitching

If you have a sewing machine with decorative stitches and you never use them this class is for you!

Required Materials List

- 1 fat quarter, tone on tone or batik without a lot of defined pattern. See sample pictures.
- 1 – 18” x 22” piece of tear away stabilizer
- 1 - 18”x 22” piece of SF101 iron on stabilizer
- Minimum is a spool of thread that is a contrasting color to your fat quarter fabric with wound bobbins.
- Basic sewing tools, pins, scissors, seam ripper

Optional Materials

- Variety of thread colors and types, embroidery, cotton, and different weights (if desired). Correct sized needles for the thread you bring.
- 1/8” and ¼” Rick Rack (if desired)
- Yarn for couching
