

4-H Project Auction

- 1. The project auction is held 30 minutes following the **4-H Round Robin Showmanship Contest on Friday**, for 4-H Exhibitors, and will be in the Livestock Pavilion.
- 2. Any project sold must have been entered, exhibited, and judged in this year's fair.
- 3. An exhibitor selling a project for \$600 or more must complete a W-9 Tax ID (social security) form and turn in to the Extension Office within 5 days of the auction.
- Project Auction entry forms must be turned in at the Extension table to a Johnson County Extension Education Foundation volunteer (4-H Exhibit Building) on Wednesday from 10am-9pm or Thursday 9am-Noon, (NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED)
- 5. Each exhibitor may sell only one entry in either the project or market animal auction.
- 6. No livestock can sell in the project auction.
- 7. Food projects must be made fresh and completely covered in a food-safe, covered container.
- 8. Project to be sold must be brought to the livestock arena on Friday between **6:30 p.m. 7:30 p.m.**
- 9. Exhibitors should dress in your 4-H apparel or appropriate clothes; No open-toed shoes, shorts, or sleeveless shirts.
- 10. Any exhibitor that has previously sold an exhibit at another county fair in the current year will NOT be eligible to sell at the Johnson County Fair.
- 11.4-H members must be present to sell at the Johnson County Fair Project Auction unless approval is given by the executive board.
- 12. Auction checks will be sent to 4-H'ers within 14 days of the sale and IRS 1099 will be issued for exhibitors paid over \$600 in sale proceeds and premiums.
