PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- ◆ **An opportunity for teens, who have at least three years of experience, to be recognized for the leadership they have dedicated to the Johnson County 4-H Program.**
- ◆ **4-H'ers who are awarded the title should actively seek opportunities to promote the Johnson County 4-H Program.**

BASE REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ **13 years of age, as of January 1st (4-H Age)**
- ◆ **Has been in the 4-H Program for a minimum of three years.**
- ◆ **Submit application by set deadline, along with digital headshot, resume, and signed commitment letter.**



SCORING OVERVIEW

- ◆ **Application - 40 Points**
- ◆ **Public Presentation - 30 Points**
- ◆ **Interview - 30 Points**



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ **Includes 1-2 page resume (refer to sample)**
- ◆ **Application typed and should not exceed 3 pages (excluding first page)**



PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- ◆ **10 Minute Presentation**
- ◆ **Topic: Promoting 4-H**
- ◆ **Audience will include a panel of three judges, along with invited family and friends**
- ◆ **Projector and table space will be provided**



PRESENTATION TIPS

- ◆ **Highly encouraged to have PowerPoint or visual aids**
- ◆ **Utilize your full 10 minutes**
- ◆ **Avoid use of notecards**
- ◆ **Share your personal 4-H experiences**
- ◆ **Practice, Practice, Practice!**



INTERVIEW INFORMATION

- ◆ **Interview will be with panel of judges, following your presentation**
- ◆ **Questions will be on 4-H, leadership, and civic engagement experiences**
- ◆ **Interview will last no longer than 10 minutes**

INTERVIEW TIPS

- ◆ **Share your personal experiences in depth**
- ◆ **Maintain eye contact with judges**
- ◆ **Talk slowly and clearly**
- ◆ **Practice before the actual judging with friends, family, or mentors**
- ◆ **Relax, be yourself, and have fun!**
